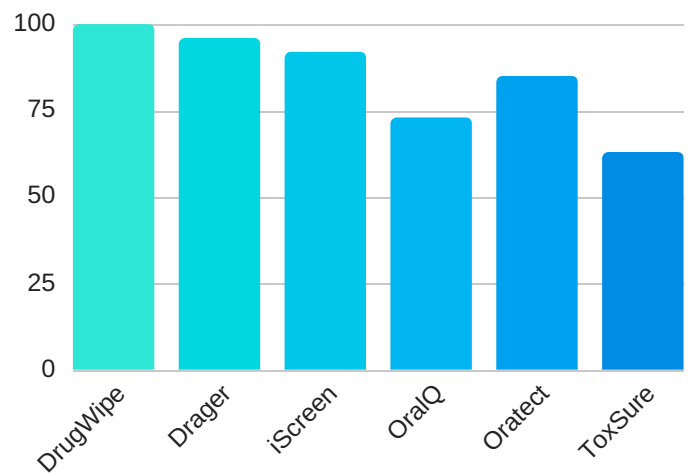

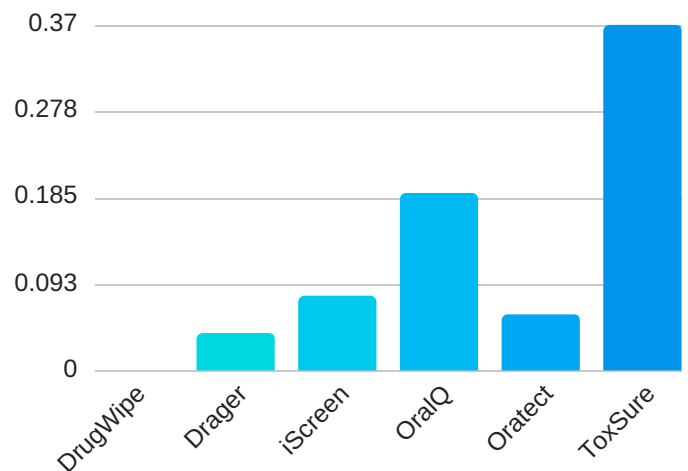

OUTSIDE OF THE STANDARD TESTING YOU MAY WANT TO CONSIDER;

Benzodiazepine testing:

The "Benzo" family includes common antidepressants such as diazepam (valium) and alprazolam (xanax) and whilst they are not illicit drugs, they often do come with warnings not to operate heavy machinery. Hence your company will need to weigh up the risks if you feel this class of drug can pose to safety versus privacy of the individual. It is worth noting a saliva test will only detect a higher dosage of these drugs, low prescriptions may not register.

Blanket testing:

In most cases drug and alcohol testing will be conducted randomly based on a number set out in your Substance Abuse Policy. You may, however, wish to test all staff equally and this is known as a 'blanket test'. Blanket testing may be for drugs and alcohol or simply alcohol depending on your needs.

Staff awareness session:

Before you begin your testing regime you may want to consider an information session for your staff where Corpcare will come in and explain the testing process and what they can expect from it. This gives your employees a chance to ask questions and get comfortable with the new policy you have set out.

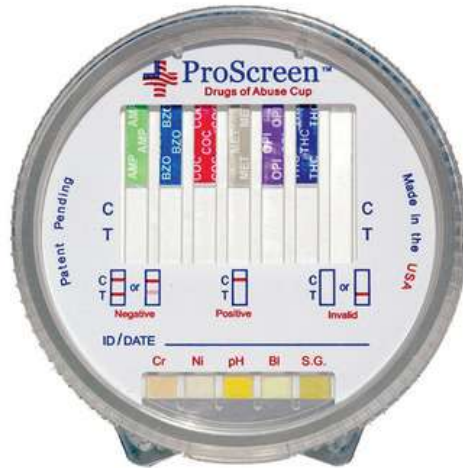

The ProScreen Drugs of Abuse (DOA) Urine Cup is an on-site urine test for the detection of illicit substances. It contains a total of 6 built in adulterants which test a variety of parameters to ensure the sample provided is a true and valid urine sample. This screening test will provide a result in 1-2 minutes by simply replacing the lid and observing the test lines.

Urine testing is considered an informative 'lifestyle' test to determine drug use in the past 1 to 30 days. The lifespan of any drug in a donor's system will depend on a number of factors including; age, gender, frequency of use and dose amount.

In a range of industries a urine test may be used for pre-employment or random testing.

A ProScreen Urine Cup is available in 6 panel format can detect a total of 6 drug classes, listed below, and is the most popular model used in workplaces. There is also a 12 panel model available which detects a wider range and is utilised in corrective services.
